Wounded Warrior Battalion Contact Centers

The Marine Corps care model ensures wounded, ill, or injured (WII) Marines and Sailors remain with or return to their units as quickly as their medical conditions will allow. Active duty WII Marines who continue to serve with their parent commands receive periodic calls from contact centers located at each Wounded Warrior Battalion (WWBn). Contact center representatives monitor Marines through their recovery within their area of responsibility, conduct outreach calls, receive calls for assistance, and provide information on programs and/or resources to ensure continuity in care. Non-medical case managers located at each contact center provide assistances to WII Marines obtaining benefits, referrals, and provide a single point of contact for external marines to benefit from WWBn support.

Wounded Warrior battalion contact centers are active outreach call centers that provide research, reference, and referrals for WII Marines and Sailors on a variety of topics including:

- Benefits and Entitlements
- Social Security Disability Insurance
- Awards (Purple Hearts)
- Veterans Affairs
- GI Bill
- Employment/Education
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- Counseling on a variety of issues
- Traumatic Servicemembers' Group Life Insurance

The contact centers also support WII Marines going through the Medical Evaluation Board/Physical Evaluation Board with resources to assist them through the Integrated Disability Evaluation System (IDES) process.
